



Guidelines for Use of Knox/Lincoln County Beekeepers Club Extractors

You may check-out one of the two available extractors if you are a member in good standing, with current year dues paid.

Check-out is for two days at a time. The two days may include a Saturday or a Sunday but not both Saturday and Sunday.

The extractor is checked out clean and must be returned clean. If the extractor is returned dirty, the member will not be allowed to check out the extractor a second time. There will be a \$20 cleaning fee applied.

Cleaning should be with **HOT WATER ONLY**, no soaps or chemicals.
